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Re: Follow up Letter - Pushing COVID-19 Vaccines on Pregnant Women

Dear Dr. Hicks and Ms. Meegan:

On March 26, 2024, you received a certified letter from Reform Pharma, an initiative of Children's Health Defense outlining our concerns that **the American College of Obstetrics and Gynecologists (ACOG) continues to use its influence to push dangerous COVID-19 injections on pregnant women.** The March 26 letter provides significant scientific evidence of the safety risks, including severe injury and death to pregnant women, their fetuses, and newborns.

The March 26 letter also highlights that ACOG took over \$11 million in grant money from the U.S. Department of Health and Human Services (HHS) as well as the Centers for Disease Control and Prevention (CDC) – both lobbying arms for the pharmaceutical industry – in exchange for pushing the COVID-19 shots on the most vulnerable of our population, knowing that the COVID-19 vaccine was an untested, unsafe, and experimental product. The public has a right to know that ACOG places profits above people.

It's time for ACOG to reconcile and admit its mistake. Stop using intimidation tactics to mislead both physicians and pregnant women. Take the proper action now to prevent further needless injury and death.

The public has a right to know that ACOG is no longer the premier medical organization that promotes women's health, but instead has become a puppet of the government that places profits over people. However, Reform Pharma is giving ACOG **until May 1, 2024** to explain in writing why ACOG is **still pushing the shots.**
