AN ACT

To amend chapter 167, RSMo, by adding thereto one new section relating to informed consent for vaccinations.

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the state of Missouri, as follows:

Section A. Chapter 167, RSMo, is amended by adding thereto one new section, to be known as section 167.184, to read as follows:

167.184. 1. A health care provider who administers vaccines shall provide all of the following information to the patient or, if the patient is a minor, the patient's parent or legal guardian or person in loco parentis of the minor before administering a vaccine:

(1) The benefits and risks of each vaccine;

(2) The vaccine manufacturer's product insert;

(3) The Centers for Disease Control and Prevention's vaccine excipient and media summary; and

(4) How to report a vaccine-adverse event.

2. Any informational or educational materials the department develops or provides to parents and guardians shall include all of the information required to be provided for informed consent under subsection 1 of this section.
