FACTS about Children’s Health

The health of our children has **dramatically** declined over the past few decades.

Over half of America’s children (54%) have one or more chronic health conditions, according to a 2011 national health survey. These conditions include neurodevelopmental disorders, asthma, allergies, mental health and behavioral disorders and obesity, among others.

One in five (22%) 13- to 18-year-olds has or will have a severe mental disorder, according to the National Institute of Mental Health. Thirty-seven percent of children aged 14 or older with a mental health condition will drop out of school.

One in six American children (17%) ages 3 to 17 years old has a developmental disability, according to the CDC. These include ADHD (13% in boys, 6%

in girls), autism (2.8%), and speech and language disorders (7.7%).

About 7.3 million public school students, or 15%, receive special education or related services under IDEA in the U.S.

In 2022, **one in 16 American children are reported to have asthma** (6.2%), according to the CDC.

One in every 13 American children (estimated 8%) has at least one food allergy, and two in 5 (40%) of those with food allergies have been treated in the emergency room.

In 2023 alone, the National Cancer Institute estimated that **15,590 children and adolescents ages 0 to 19 will be diagnosed with cancer**, and 1,590 will die of the disease.

Everyone has a stake in the quest to restore our children’s health. **Children are the keys to our successful future**; we don’t have a moment, or the health of any child, to lose. Our mission is to end childhood health epidemics by working aggressively to eliminate harmful exposures, hold those responsible accountable and establish safeguards to prevent future harm. We fight corruption, mass surveillance and censorship that put profits before people as well as advocate for worldwide rights to health freedom and bodily autonomy.

Goals

To identify and eliminate hazardous exposures that are driving an epidemic of chronic and devastating health conditions in our children in the U.S. and globally.

Over 50% of the children in the U.S. suffer from a chronic health condition. Unprecedented epidemics — including autism, ADHD, allergies, asthma, autoimmune diseases and obesity — have stolen children's potential and wreaked havoc on their health. These health conditions began plaguing our

children in the past three decades, pointing to an environmental etiology.

Hold accountable the individuals, agencies and industries responsible for causing harm or knowingly failing to protect our children.

Our federal agencies and industries are well aware that the continued use of toxicants — including glyphosate, thimerosal, aluminum, fluorid, asbestos, electromagnetic radiation and many other exposures — is dangerous, yet have failed to support policies that would have eliminated these exposures despite recommendations made by the Institute of Medicine and other scientific authorities.

Establish safeguards to prevent man-made health epidemics from ever happening again.

Numerous failures on the part of our lawmakers and regulatory agencies have led to continual public exposures to glyphosate, mercury, aluminum and other neurotoxins and carcinogens. With appropriate federal policies, infrastructure, legislation and oversight, such failures can be prevented in the future.
